### What?

- 2) Send up to five individual sample student Dream Flags to be brought to Khumjung, connected to other student flags, and exhibited for their celebration. *These will be returned to you.*

### How?

ALL FLAGS must be weatherproof, 8 1/2 x 11 in. or 22 x 28 cm. (vertical), and securely connected to a line. They will be hung *outside* for several days. 50th Anniversary Flags should include: **Your group's name, city, state, and country.** Student Dream Flags should include: Group/school name and location on the bottom. All interested Dream Flag schools are invited to send special Dream Flags to go to "the roof of the world." They'll fly at the Khumjung School of Nepal, in the shadow of Mt. Everest.

The Flags will connect with Dream Flags of the Khumjung students as they celebrate the 50th anniversary of their school, founded by Sir Edmund Hillary. This celebration will happen on May 29, 2011.

From May 22-June 1 staff from The Dream Flag Project will trek the flags to Khumjung and send posts, pictures, and maybe even video all along the way. Teachers may be able to send on-line questions from their classes as well.

Our Dream Flags were born from prayer flag images of this area just eight years ago. Please help complete this full circle of hope.
