Each year in Philadelphia we celebrate the amazing diversity of dreams that comes from what schools create when they participate in **The Dream Flag Project**. It's a free event for everyone.

Over the years, the volunteer efforts have created a carnival of poetry and dreams. Before the program, students can decorate Dream Flag tee-shirts, create Dream Flag buttons, work on a common dream banner, make Dream Flag music, read at an open mike for Dream Flag poetry, and admire some of 2-3,000 Dream Flags on display.

During the program, representative readers from each school take the stage to read their Dream Flag poems while musicians improvise accompaniment, then we ceremonially connect a 2-3,000 Dream Flags and join in song.

We hope that one and all can join us for this hope-filled and joyous event!
